

Bannaby's third sale

BANNABY Angus stud operations are based five kilometres out of Taralga on Strathaird Lane.

Bannaby Angus began as a commercial herd in 1990. The commercial herd now numbers over 1,000 females. The stud herd was established in 2003 with purchases from Comfort Hill, Millah Murrah, Wallaroy and Lawsons. Females have been progressively added to the stud herd, most recently from The Grange and Vermont dispersals, including the \$45,000 Australian record priced female, Vermont Dream B227.

Our third annual bull sale will be held on Saturday, August 24, at which 50 bulls will be offered. This year we are offering 16 month and 24 month old bulls.

Bulls will include some outstanding sons of HF Tiger, GAR Ultimate, Te Mania Berkley, Te Mania Infinity and Bannaby Admiral D34 (a participant in the first round of the Angus Benchmarking study) from some of our leading donor dams, including



Vermont Dream B227, Vermont Dream E145, The Grange Yr Blackbird C66, Vermont Queenie Z342, Vermont Kite C240 and Millah Murrah Rado Y119 (the dam of super growth sire Millah Murrah Equator D78).

Sale bulls will be on display for Beef Week, together with a selection of stud and commercial females.
